4. Basis and Purpose for Processing

- **Legitimate Uses:** As defined under the DPDP Act (e.g., for necessary and reasonable purposes like responding to inquiries).

The sole purpose of data processing is:

- To respond to your inquiries and provide customer/business support.
- To ensure the security and functionality of the website.
